$$7 \times 4 = 28$$

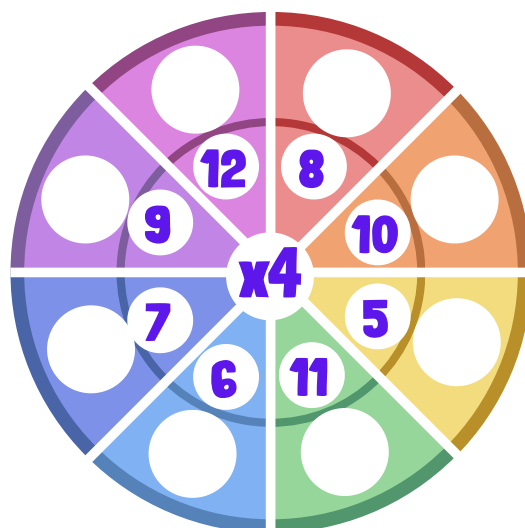
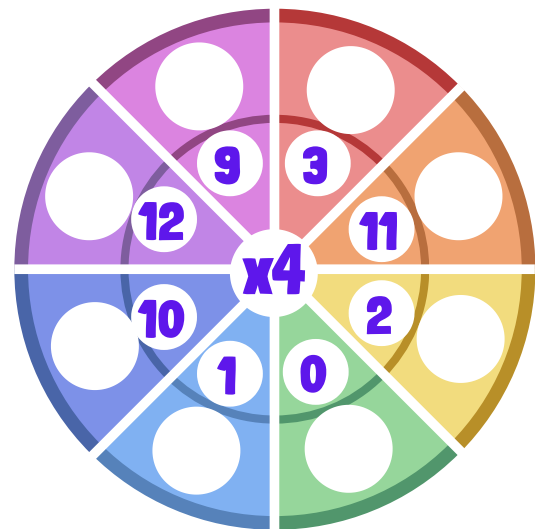
$$8 \times 4 = 32$$

$$11 \times 4 = 44$$

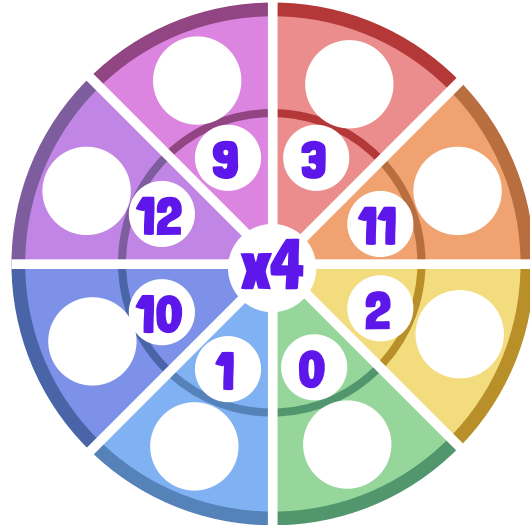
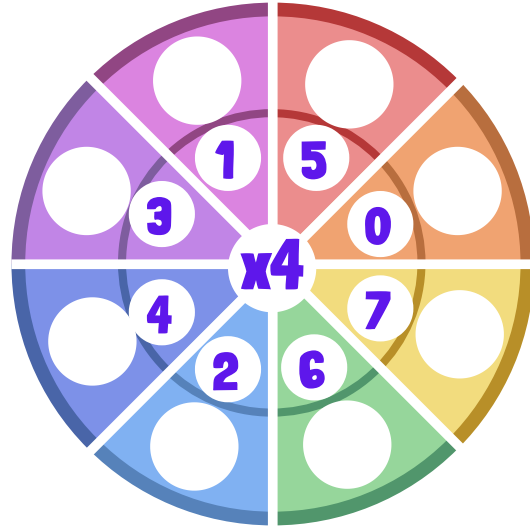
